- This competition will be run under HRCav Rules and Regulations.
- Competitors must ride at their assessed HRCav level and may ride one level higher.
- THIS WILL BE A CARDLESS EVENT. The HRCav Membership Database will be checked prior to the event to confirm membership status and current level assessment –cards WILL NOT be required to be presented (i.e online check-in only –no physical check in required). Riders receiving points will be required to update their own cards (instructions will be provided).
- Competitors are to provide their own bridle/saddlecloth numbers. Numbers are to be worn on both sides of the horse.
- Competitors must present to gear check 20 minutes prior to their first dressage test and be wearing approved riding helmets and riding boots.
- Protests must be lodged within 30mins of posting interim scores & must be accompanied by \$20.00.
- No secondary protests may be entered into. The decision of the Ground Jury is final.
- No refunds will be issued unless a valid Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate is provided within 14days of the completion of the event. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- AARC accepts no responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to any competitor, spectator, horse, equipment or property.
- HRCav extreme weather policy and horse welfare shall be observed. Should weather conditions be unsuitable for running a safe event, the committee reserved to right to postpone or cancel. Competitors will be advised immediately. Please note that in such circumstances, an administration fee of \$10 per entry will be withheld to help recover incurred costs.
- AARC reserves the right to cancel any class, to divide any class, to alter the advertised times and to decline any entry without stating a reason.
- Dogs are welcome but MUST be on a lead at all times. Penalty of elimination for unrestrained dogs will be enforced and you will be asked to leave.
